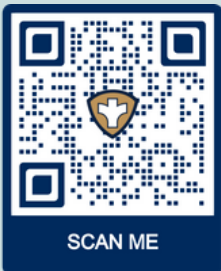

# Do you need help getting a COVID-19 vaccine in Brown County?

## Vaccination Cost and Access

- The COVID-19 vaccination is free. If you receive a bill contact the organization that sent the bill or a community support agency (see below).
- Social Security number and insurance are not required to receive the vaccine.
- Please call your provider, a community support agency (see below), or Brown County Public Health if you encounter difficulty with billing or access.

**Curative Connections:** call 920-468-1161 for availability of rides

**Uber Health:** call 920-448-6400 to schedule a ride

**Medical Transportation Management (MTM):** for those enrolled in certain programs, including: Wisconsin Medicaid, IRIS, BadgerCare Plus, call 866-907-1493 to schedule a ride

**Green Bay Metro Transit bus system:** call 920-448-3450 or download the app to see route schedules. *When boarding tell the driver you are going to get your COVID-19 vaccine.*
