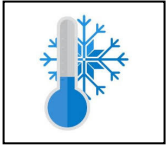

It is also a good idea to have an extra sweatshirt/sweater on hand if they get cold while in their classroom.



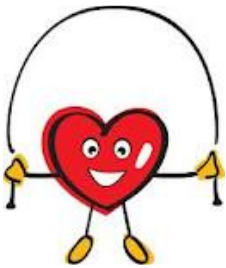
5th Grade Events

Breakfast News

In case parents are not aware, District Security Protocol requires ALL outside doors to be locked. This includes our Breakfast Doors. At 8:35AM, a staff person will arrive to let students enter in for breakfast. That person then will supervise the café and monitor the doors to allow other students to enter. It is possible that students might have to wait a couple of minutes to gain entry as the adult will be traveling between the café and the breakfast doors. **Students arriving at/after 8:50am are too late** for breakfast as students are finished with breakfast and leaving to line up with their class. It is important that your children arrive approximately at 8:35am if you would like them to eat breakfast at school. It is essential for all children to have a healthy breakfast to start their day of learning—THANK YOU for your help!

SCHOOL WEATHER CLOSINGS INFORMATION

Here is important information regarding school weather closings.

With the winter season upon us, I need to share some important reminders about school closings and delays.

Notifications:

- In order to ensure families are notified of a school closing or delay the District will notify the media as well as post information on Facebook, Twitter and District/school websites.
- When schools close early due to inclement weather, the District will notify the media at least ONE hour before the first students are released. Parents are also encouraged to check the District's Facebook, Twitter and District/school websites for up-to-date information.

Early Dismissal for WEATHER:

When the District determines the early dismissal time, KING School will dismiss students at approximately an hour later. For example: District dismissal is 10:00AM; King will be one hour later at 11:00AM.

- For early dismissal days due to inclement weather, it is important that families have a plan in place. Students will not be dismissed prior to the assigned time unless parents/guardians pick them up.
- For parents/guardians who are working, it is necessary for your children and the school to have instructions regarding what they should do and where they will go, if you will be staying at work.

**If school is in session and it is below zero (with or without the wind chill), students will be inside for recess(es).

This includes the time before school from 8:35AM to 8:57AM. Students should not come to school prior to 8:35AM as there is no supervision and students will not be allowed inside until 8:35AM.

**On inclement weather mornings, Safety Patrols are posted at all of the doors to direct students to their own coat hook area at 8:40AM.

Finally, I want to remind families that parents/guardians can always determine if they would prefer their students to remain home from school on inclement weather days, should the decision be made to not close schools. In addition, should you decide that you would prefer to pick your child up on an inclement weather day, if school will not be dismissed early, you may do that as well. In either case, please be sure to notify the school office.

LATE START for WEATHER: When the District determines that late start is necessary due to weather students may begin arriving **NO EARLIER than 10:35am. Supervision will not be available until that time and it is too dangerous for students to be outside alone.** There will also be **NO BREAKFAST served.**
