



ONLINE VIRTUAL LEARNING

Utica Community Schools, in conjunction is pleased to offer an online learning experience to current secondary UCS students. This program will afford students an opportunity to earn one-half credit toward graduation requirements per online course.

The online courses are self-paced with an open starting date but a fixed end date. Students set their own pace based on the rigor of the course and the time available. Certified instructors will set guidelines for completing assignments, grade coursework and be available to students for questions. School assigned mentors will encourage students and monitor their progress.

Students must meet with their school counselor to select the appropriate course to fulfill UCS graduation requirements. UCS students will earn a letter grade corresponding with the district grading policy for the online course. This grade will be reflected on the student's high school transcripts. The student needs to begin working on coursework as soon as the course opens.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why would I want to participate in this program?

If you have additional electives or core courses you are interested in taking but are unable to fit them in your schedule because of the number of required courses.

Can I graduate from high school early because of the credits earned through the online learning experience?

No, these courses can be used to fulfill graduation requirements but not to graduate early.

Will this course appear on my transcript when applying to colleges & universities?

Yes, these courses will be included on your transcript.

How do I register for a course?

- Meet with your counselor
- Fill out the form (side 2)
- Have parent/guardian sign form
- Return the form to counselor

ENROLLMENT TYPES

○ 21F (course taken as part of student's daily schedule outside of the school environment; no charge)

Final semester exams must be taken in the presence of a UCS employee. Students will earn a letter grade corresponding with the district grading policy for the online course. This grade will be reflected on the student's high school transcript.

○ Credit Forward – Courses taken in the summer or outside of the school day through Michigan Virtual. All credit forward courses are taken at home; parent pays enrollment fee.

If the student would like the letter grade earned displayed on their transcript, the exam must be taken in the presence of a UCS employee. If the exam is taken at home, credit (CR) will be awarded upon successful completion. Courses will be included on transcript with final letter grade or credit (CR) earned.
