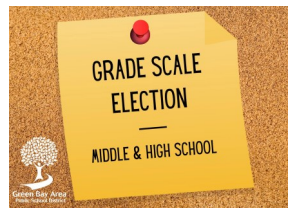


2020-2021 PARKING PERMIT APPLICATIONS

The 2020-2021 Parking Permit applications are available on the Preble website under the Students/Parents tab, [2020-2021 Parking Permit Application & Guidelines](#).

Applicants must have a parking permit application on file along with a copy of their driver's license prior to or on **Monday, July 27, 2020**. Payments will be accepted during student registration. Parking application forms must be completed in full to be considered for a parking permit. Late applicants will be accepted and/or placed on a waiting list.

Applicants with outstanding fines/fees as of **Monday, July 27, 2020** will not be considered for a parking permit. Students will not be added to the waiting list until these issues are resolved. For more information, contact Ms. Kosnar in the main office.



GRADE ELECTION FOR MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Last month the district communicated the grading guidelines for the school closure. The guidelines allow parents/guardians to determine their middle or high school student's final grade for second semester/third trimester courses. As a reminder, parents/guardians can determine whether their students will earn a letter grade or a Pass/No Grade COVID-19 Closure.

Parents can access Grade Scale Election, a web application, through Parent Portal where parents/guardians can indicate by course the type of grade they wish their student to receive. Please note that parents/guardians can make a determination for all courses except dual credit courses in which students have indicated that they are completing the course for college credit. If a selection for letter grade is not made by a parent/guardian, the student's grade will default to Pass/No Grade COVID-19 Closure.

Parents/guardians are asked to complete this process by **June 9, 2020**. If you have any questions on how to access Parent Portal or the Grade Scale Election web application, please contact the District's Help Desk at 920-448-2148. Questions regarding your student's grade in a course should be directed to the appropriate teacher.

MAIN OFFICE SUMMER HOURS

SENIOR EMAIL ACCOUNTS



All students have access to their GBAPS accounts for 90 days after their fina enrollment ends. This includes seniors. The Chromebooks are locked down to only allow GBAPS accounts with the exception of NWTC Google accounts. However, students should be able to transfer their content using this process: <https://support.google.com/accounts/answer/6386856>. We have enabled it only for seniors.

STUDENT FOLDERS/FILES

All student folders and files saved in student directories (M: Drives) will be erased, except for IB students. Students wishing to keep files should save them to their Google Drive, CDs or flash drives. Graduating seniors will have access to their district M: Drive and Google account for 90 days following graduation.

WORK PERMITS



Work permits will be issued by the Department of Workforce Development (DWD). Currently, the Department of Workforce Development is currently allowing minors to work without a permit.

1. The student/parent needs to collect: the student's birth certificate, Social Security card, and written consent from their parent.
2. The student/parent needs to present those documents to the employer.
3. The employer drafts an intent to hire/ job offer letter.
4. The employer should call DWD and they will process all of this information/documentation over the phone with the employer and grant permission for the student to work without a permit, if applicable (they still cannot work in hazardous environments, etc.).
