ADVISORY

Every teacher will have a group of students between 15-20 that they will mentor whether we are virtual, hybrid or onsite. The purpose of this advisory period is to strengthen communication among students, between faculty and students, and to develop communication links between the school and home. It is imperative that your child attend advisory every day, as this impacts your child's connection to our school. This period will also be used to take student attendance and share morning announcements. Announcements will also be placed on our school website.

ATTENDANCE

The school attendance policy is outlined in the Student Expectation Booklet. It is important that you call the Attendance Office at (920) 391-2403 to report the absence of your child.

If your child misses class, you will receive an automated call, informing you that s(he) was absent.

Families can pick up a breakfast, lunch and dinner on Monday through Friday from 9-1 pm at Door 24 across from the football field.

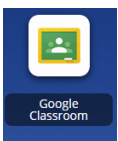
