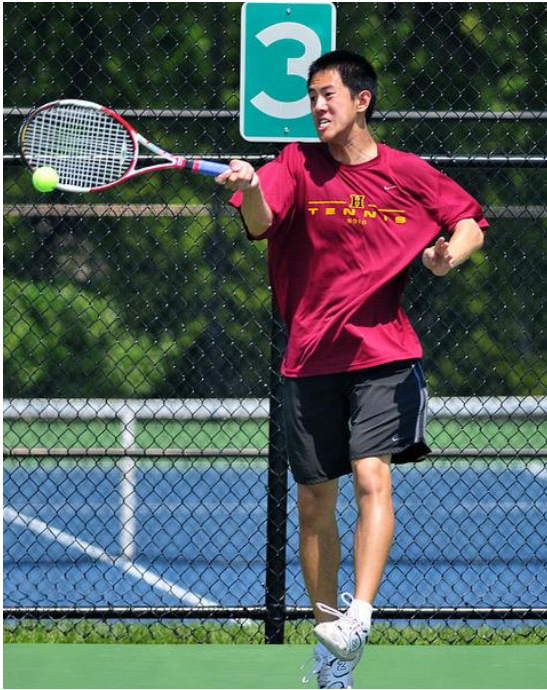


Steven Wu



Steven Wu had an incredibly decorated career at Hillsborough high school and beyond. As a freshman in 2007, Steven made 3rd Team All State Group 4 and reached the 3rd round of the NJSIAA tournament while finishing ranked #17 in the state's top 20 singles. Despite suffering a broken elbow in 2008, he was ranked #20 and again reached the 3rd round of the NJSIAAs. In 2009, Steven was First Team All Conference, All Area, All Group. He was Somerset County Champion, and County Player of the year. During his senior campaign, Steven Wu earned First Team All Conference, First Team All Area, and 2nd Team All State - Group IV and made it to the 4th Round of the NJSIAAs. He was also named the 2010 Hillsborough Senior Male Scholar Athlete of the year. Steven is the all time Hillsborough High School career wins holder with a record of 75-13-2 in singles play.

After graduating from Hillsborough, Steven continued his successful tennis career at NYU. He was a Division III All American in 2013 and 2014 and was the team's MVP in his sophomore and senior seasons. Steven was a three-time University Athletic Association (UAA) Athlete of the Week, and two-time Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Athlete of the Week. He played at 1st or 2nd singles and 1st or 2nd doubles positions all 4 seasons. As a senior, Steven finished the 2014 regular season ranked #2 in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) Division III Northeast Regional singles rankings. Steven also finished the 2014 full season ranked #18 in the final ITA National singles rankings. In 2014, he became the first NYU player to compete in the national NCAA Division III Tennis Championship since 2002. He led his team at first singles and doubles positions as a senior to an Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) end-of-season #30 national ranking. Steven was the singles runner-up at the 2013 Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) Division III Northeast Regional Championship, and he was named to 2014 CoSIDA Academic All-America Second Team by Division III College Sports Information Directors of America as a senior.
