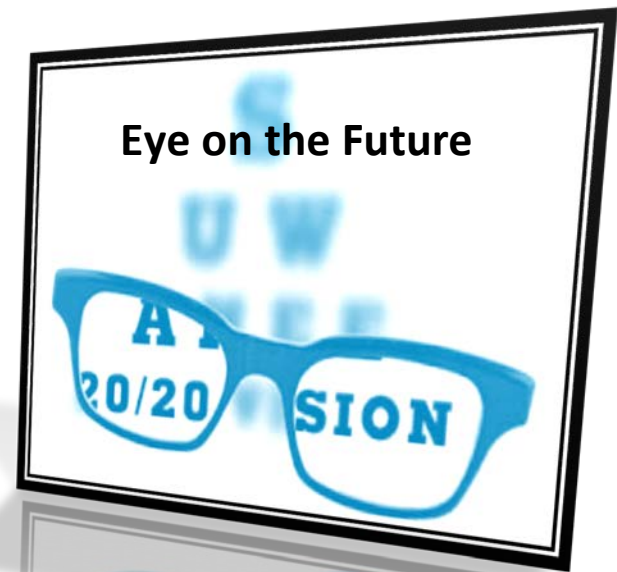
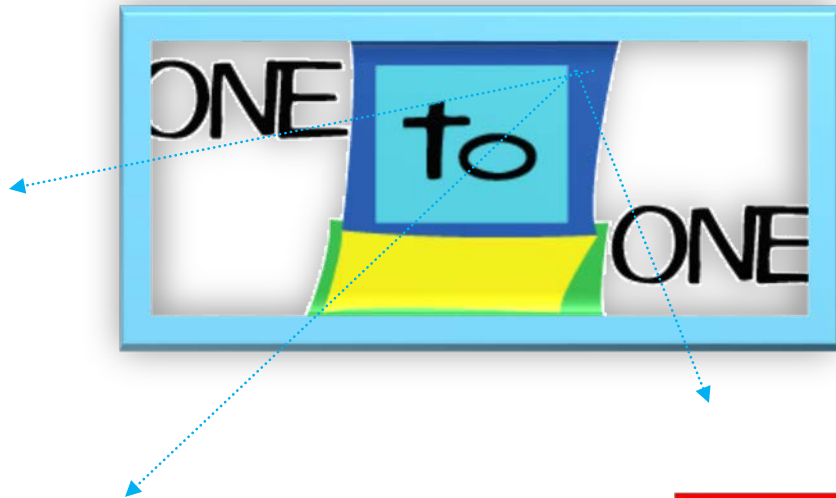

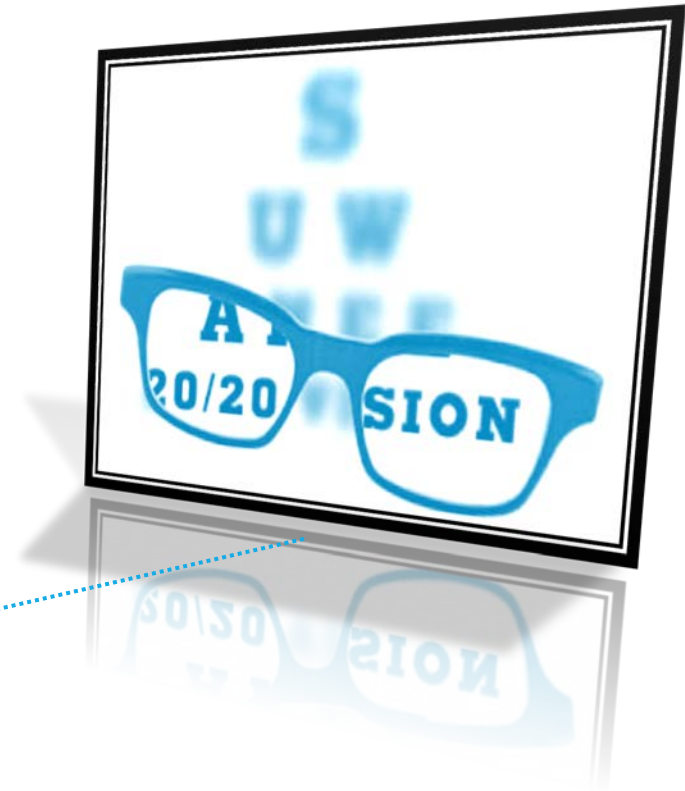

“Redesign of Alleghany High School”

A partnership with the New Tech Network to implement project based learning at Alleghany High School.

Whole school implementation – culminating activity: Internship/real life experience for all students

The project based learning program is to be phased in over a three year period;

- 9th and 10th grade classes will begin during the 2018 – 19 school year;
- 11th grade classes will begin during the 2019 – 20 school year; and
- 12th grade classes will begin during the 2020 – 21 school year.

Timeline of events

June, 2014 – AHS teachers identified the New Tech program as a program to assist in moving the high school from good to great

December, 2014 – December, 2016 - meetings and visits to New Tech Network schools to evaluate the benefits of project based learning and the New Tech Network program.

January, 2017 – School Board approves the implementation of project based learning and the New Tech network program

March, 2017 – School Board approves the location of the New Tech Network program at Alleghany High School

April, 2017 – Staff visit Lakeland High School, Indiana to view a whole school implementation model of project based learning and the New Tech Network program

April and May, 2017 – meetings held with high school staff to plan for the “Redesign of Alleghany High School” through the implementation of project based learning and the New Tech Network.

July, 2017 – several AHS staff members attend the Teacher Residency and New Tech Network Annual Conference – begin staff development training

August, 2017 – AHS leadership team begins meeting to plan the implementation of project based learning through the New Tech Network

September – November, 2017 – High School staff will meet twice a month to develop the plan of implementation. Each staff member will serve on a work group. Leadership members will chair the workgroups.

- Assessment
- Facilities/grants

September 27, 2017 – Henry County Public Schools visit – Entire AHS teaching staff and eighth grade teachers will visit Magna Vista and Bassett High Schools

Contract agreement with the New Tech Network to be completed by October 1, 2017 (approximately). AHS will identify the following:

- New Tech Network director;
- Thought person/lead teacher;
- ECHO (learning management system) manager; and
- All teaching staff to be trained in project based learning.

December 1, 2017 – Plan of implementation completed (tentative)

Leadership Residency: Registration for New Tech Principal/Director and additional thought partner(s) at a New Tech Network school or schools.
